- ii) Assessments will be continuous and comprehensive throughout the session in the form of Subject Enrichment Activities (SEA) and Note Book Maintenance (NBM) in both the terms separately. Note Book maintenance will include tidy covers, neat & meticulous work & proper upkeep of note book throughout the session. Subject Enrichment Activities will be conducted in the form of quizzes, debates, speeches, assignments, interviews, informal tests, projects, practicals etc.

### FOR ADMISSION IN CLASS XI

#### **Eligibility :**

**For Science (PCM) :** a minimum of 75% marks in Science and Mathematics separately, in the written examination of X CBSE.

**For Science (PCB) :** a minimum of 70% marks in Science and Mathematics separately, in the written examination of X CBSE.

**For Commerce :** a minimum of 65% (overall) in written examination of X CBSE.

**For Humanities :** a minimum of 65% (overall) in written examination of X CBSE.
