With refrence to your application dated 26.6.2003 and subsequent correspondence with the school/inspection in this regard, I am directed to convey the sanction for Provisional/Composite Provisional Affiliation for Secondary School Examination of the Board for a period of **three** years w.e.f. 1.4.2004 to 31.3.2007

The above sanction is subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

1. The school will follow the national syllabus for the middle classes.
2. The school will follow syllabi and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary School Examination and changes made therein from time to time.
3. The School shall appoint only qualified and eligible staff .
4. The school will help the Board in the smooth conduct of the examination by providing the necessary accommodation i.e. Rooms, Halls, etc available in the school premises and furniture at its disposal for holding its examinations free of charge, if required.
5. The School will spare sufficient teachers, for invgilation purpose at the examinations of the Board, as may be required.
6. The school will spare its teachers for evaluation of Answer-Books for the Board's examinations, if required.
7. The school will provide the laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board.
8. The School will abide itself by conditions of affiliation already prescribed or may be prescribed by the Board from time to time.
9. Service agreement be executed with the staff as per norms generally accepted by the State Government concerned.
10. Service conditions, pay and allowance and other benefits to the employees of the school shall be in no way less than that of corresponding employees working in Government schools of the state

in which the school is located. An undertaking to this effect be sent to CBSE.

11. The school and its records shall be opened for inspection by an officer/ official of the Board or an authorised representative of the Board/State Education department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.
12. The rate of tuition fee and other fee charged should be commensurate with the facilities provided.

14. No unrecognised classes shall run with in the premises of the school or outside in the same name of school.
15. The school will not sponsor the candidates for Board's examination of any other School/Branch which is not affiliated.
16. The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation-Bye-Laws/Rules of the Directorate of Education, Delhi in the joint names.
17. The school should not start class XI/XII without written approval of the Board. The Board shall not be responsible for any consequences in case class XI/XII is started without following the Affiliation-Bye-Laws and obtaining the prior approval of the Board.

19. Annual fee @ Rs. 1000/- per annum for the year (s) **three years**..... be also remitted at an early date, (In case of overseas Independent School @ Rs. 5000/- p.a. and overseas Kendriya Vidyalayas @ Rs. 3500/- p.a.)

Dear Sir/Madam

With reference to your application dated 23.05.2008 on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey sanction for Extension of Provisional Affiliation of the school with the Board for its **Secondary and Senior Secondary School Examinations** for a period of **five year(s)** w.e.f. **01.04.2009** to **31.03.2014** in the subjects in which the School already stands affiliated, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

1. The School is required to follow syllabi and course as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for the respective Examination.
2. The School is required to abide itself by the Examination/Affiliation-Bye-Laws of the Board.
3. The School is required to apply online through CBSE website www.cbseaff.nic.in for further extension of affiliation on the prescribed Application Form along with the requisite fee and other documents by 30th June of the preceding year in which the Provisional Affiliation expires.
4. Some of the teachers of the school are untrained, whereas the school is required to appoint qualified staff and pay salary, DA and other admissible allowances at par with the corresponding categories of employees working in the State Govt. Schools.
5. The school is required to appoint sufficient no. of qualified and trained teachers to maintain section teacher ratio 1:1.5 for each level i.e. primary, Secondary and Senior Secondary i.e. 1:1.5 besides Principal, PTI and Librarian at Primary/Secondary/Sr. Secondary levels.
6. As per details of enrolment given by the school, it is not maintaining optimum number of enrolment of students in each class, hence section-wise enrollment of students may be maintained with optimum number of 40 students per section.
7. Other conditions are enclosed as per **Annexure 'A'**.

Compliance of the above conditions should reach to this office within **three** months from date of issue of this letter.
