**Part B –**

Half Yearly Examination 100 Marks (Theory + Practical)

**Part C –**

Annual Examination 100 Marks (Theory + Practical)

(Pre-Board I & II followed by Board Examination for Class XII)

ii) **Promotion Rules:**

Minimum 33% marks in the final examination as well as in the grand total i.e. **Part A+ Part B+ Part C**, in all the subjects to qualify for promotion to class XII.

In subjects with practical examination minimum 33% marks in theory and practical separately is a must.

iii) **Re-examination:** Will be conducted on the failure in one subject only.

No Re-test will be conducted for students who take uninformed leave that have not been sanctioned by the School Management. However, Management's discretion will be used in special cases.

### **For Admission in Class XI**

**Eligibility:**

**For Science (PCM):** a minimum of 75% marks in Science and Mathematics separately, in the written examination of X CBSE.

**For Science (PCB):** a minimum of 70% marks in Science and Mathematics separately, in the written examination of X CBSE.

**For Commerce:** a minimum of 65% (overall) in written examination of X CBSE.

**For Humanities:** a minimum of 65% (overall) in written examination of X CBSE.
